
CMV Vaccine & Migraines studies.

CMV Vaccine

CMV is a common virus. Over half of adults in the U.S. have it in their body by age 40. CMV spreads easily through an infected person's saliva or other body fluids. It's related to the herpes virus, which gives you cold sores.



Migraines

are a common type of headache that is characterized by an intense throbbing or pulsing in one area of the head and are commonly accompanied by nausea, vomiting, or extreme sensitivity to light and sound. For some sufferers, migraines are preceded or accompanied by auras, flashes of light or blind spots. Migraines typically last between four and 72 hours.

March is Endometriosis Awareness Month.

Endometriosis is an inflammatory condition where endometrial tissue grows outside of the uterus. It is estimated that 1 in 10 women have endometriosis. Endometriosis frequently presents with the symptom of pain including painful periods, pain during sexual intercourse, and chronic pelvic or abdominal pain.

Endometriosis can cause infertility and for women with subfertility the prevalence rate ranges from 25% to 40%
